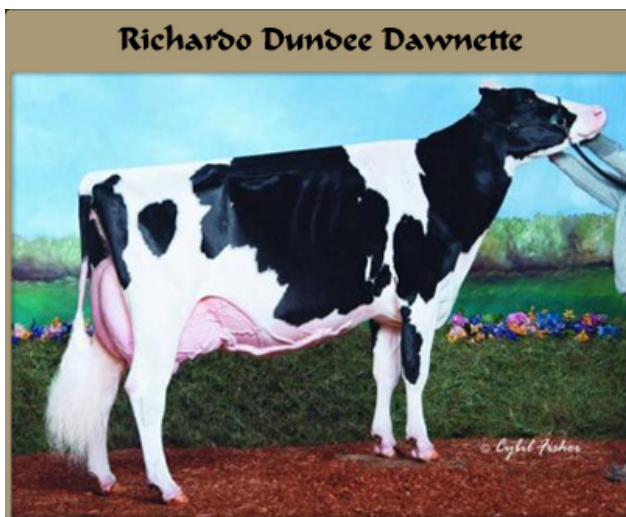

Dawnette has classified Excellent-95 with 95-MS and 95 FL. She was Reserve All-American and Honorable Mention All-Canadian 5-year old in 2010. Dawnette earned 3rd place in the 5-year old class at the Canada National Holstein Show in 2010. She placed fifth during the 5-year old class at the International Holstein Show in 2010. At the 2010 Ontario Spring Show, Dawnette was 1st 5 year-old and earned Best Udder and Grand Champion.

Dawnette is pregnant and due to calve in August of 2011. In February, Dawnette traveled from her home in Ontario, Canada to her new home

in western New York specifically to utilize IVF technology. In March of 2011 Dawnette entered the IVF ET program with Trans Ova Genetics and Perry Veterinary Clinic.

IVF technology allows embryos to be made from the donor cow even while she is pregnant. On March 4th, 7 Dawnette embryos, sired by Goldwyn, were transferred into Roll-N-View heifers in Nunda, NY. At ultrasound examination, 5 heifers were confirmed pregnant.

With IVF procedures, embryos can be created every 2 weeks, compared to every 6 weeks using conventional ET procedures. On March 18th, 6 Dawnette embryos, sired by Pine-Tree Sid were transferred. Upon ultrasound examination, 5 heifers were confirmed pregnant.

Using IVF technology, Todd Galton has made 10 pregnancies from an elite cow. Even more exciting is the fact that these pregnancies were created even while Dawnette was carrying her own calf!
